Poverty continues to have a distinctly rural face, with half of the rural poor continuing to live in seven chronically poor provinces. Access to water and sanitation is inadequate in rural areas. The gap to access health care is huge, especially for women, the poor and the people living in rural/remote areas. Women and girls still face the challenges of stereotypical attitudes on traditional gender roles, unplanned childbirths, heavy workload, and restricted opportunities for better education, especially in rural areas.
