

## Portarlinton Drive Day 25<sup>th</sup> June 2017

There will be two Meeting points:

Meet at 9.00am for 9.15 departure at Todd Road Service Westbound to Geelong on the Westgate Freeway

or

Meet at 10.00am for 10.15 departure at Little River Services on Princes Freeway (Cnr Pousties Road)

Depart Avalon Service heading towards Geelong for approx. 8 kms. Take the exit signposted A10 Geelong City Centre

Follow the A10 for approx. 11 kms. Turn left onto Bell Parade. Follow Bell Parade through Geelong along the beachfront past the Royal Geelong Yacht Club.

Take the next right onto Bellarine Street and then turn immediately left onto Brougham Street. Continue on Brougham Street and then turn left onto Hearne Parade where we will enter the Geelong Revival Hill Climb Track. Continue on the twisties past the East Geelong Golf Club and at the T Junction turn left onto Portarlinton Road.

Follow Portarlinton Road (C123) for 16 kms towards Drysdale. Straight through the first roundabout and continue for 2 kms. Continue straight through the next roundabout and at the next roundabout turn right onto Moorooduc Road (C125) towards St Leonards/ Indented Heads. Continue on the Moorooduc Road and straight through at the roundabout for approximately 10 kms, turn right onto Bluff Road.

Continue to follow Bluff Road along the beachfront through St Leonards and Indented Heads for approx. 10 kms. Turn right onto The Esplanade and continue for 5 kms to Portarlinton. At the T Junction turn right then immediately left and park under the pine trees at the beachfront.

We should arrive at approximately 11.30 where you will find the lovely resort town of Portarlinton. There is a local market in the gardens at the top of the hill or enjoy an invigorating walk along the pier and beachfront. The local Bakery offers some of the yummiest cakes, pastries and wood fired baked bread.

Meet back at 12.30 where all cars are to head towards the caravan park, turn left to the roundabout at the top of the hill, turn right onto Portarlinton.

Continue on the Portarlinton Road for approximately 5.5 kms, turn left at Bellarine Estate and take the left entrance to car park.

We have reserved tables for lunch at 1.00pm and attached are two menu's

The owner of Bellarine Estate, Peter Kenny, has a collection of antique cars and trucks that were collected by his father. Peter also runs Faith Restorations available to the local youths in the Bellarine area and after lunch we will be permitted to view the collection and restoration area. Please see details attached.
